This Week's focus: Patience

What does it mean to be patient?



Patience is being able to wait for something while having a positive attitude and without getting upset. It can be difficult sometimes!

There are many benefits to being patient. **Patience improves our physical, emotional, and social health.**

Learning to wait and to take turns are important elements of learning patience.

Kids who are patient remain calm, even if they feel quite impatient that things are taking longer than they expect.

The Importance of Teaching Patience to Kids

The importance of kids learning patience is that it teaches them delayed gratification. This is the lesson that you must sometimes wait to get what you want; it does not always come to you immediately. This in turn helps them with their health, relationships, and other benefits in adulthood such as career success and fulfillment.
